Visiting your GP during the COVID-19 (coronavirus) Pandemic



Your GP surgery is open for urgent and routine problems.

To keep our patients and staff safe; all appointments will be via telephone, video or online assessment initially. Most problems can be dealt effectively in this way, a face-to-face appointment will only be arranged only if it is clinically necessary.

Your surgery has steps in place to ensure that it is safe should you need to attend in person. These measures include socially-distanced waiting areas, hand sanitisers and members of the team wearing personal protective equipment eg masks/visors. To help us:

- Please do not enter the practice unless you've been advised to
- Please attend alone, or with only 1 carer/ parent as necessary
- Please bring your own <u>face covering</u> to your appointment

Finally, it is important that you do not ignore symptoms that may need medical attention.
